LEGISLATION

1. Third reading – Ord - Accept 6 buses from the Ross County Board of Developmental Disabilities and appropriate \$3.00 to cover 2013 costs.
2. Third reading – Ord - Authorize a services contract with the Ross County Board of Developmental Disabilities to provide transportation services for its clients.
3. First reading – Ord - Authorize the Mayor to execute a contract, accepting \$10,418.00 from the Ohio Department of Transportation.
4. First reading – Ord - Appropriate \$7,500.00 to cover Engineering Code Enforcement costs for the remainder of the 2013 calendar year.
5. First reading – Ord - Temporarily suspend the maximum hours established for one part-time security officer for the Chillicothe Municipal Court.
6. First reading – Ord - Appropriate \$16,667.00 received as security as the result of a structure fire at 559-561 East Second Street, Chillicothe, Ohio.
7. First reading – Ord - Appropriate \$10,089.80 received as security as the result of a structure fire at 3 Marlboro Drive, Chillicothe, Ohio.
8. First reading – Ord - Appropriate \$30,000.00 for income tax refunds.
9. First reading – Ord - Authorize the transfer of \$4,300.00 for Civil Service Commission Administrator salary.
10. First reading – Ord - Accept \$20,888.00 grant monies received from the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program to be shared between the Chillicothe Police Department and the Ross County Sheriff's Office.
11. First reading – Ord - Amending Chapter 1501.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Chillicothe pertaining to enforcement of the Ohio Fire Code.
12. First reading – Ord - Authorize the transfer of Safety Levy Capital funds for vehicle repair costs.
13. First reading – Ord - Transfer and appropriate funds to cover mandatory Police and Fire Department pension payments.
